<b>STEP 2</b> MONTH 3-4	<b>WORK PERMIT STEP A: SUBMISSION OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST TO THE PROVINCE</b>	<b>CAN\$25 000</b>
<b>STEP 3</b> MONTH 6-10	<b>WORK PERMIT STEP B: RECEPTION OF INVITATION TO APPLY (DEPENDING ON DRAWS)</b>	<b>CAN\$25 000</b>
<b>STEP 4</b> MONTH 8-12	<b>WORK PERMIT STEP C: ISSUANCE OF LETTER OF SUPPORT ("LOS") FOR THE WORK PERMIT VISA APPLICATION</b>	<b>CAN\$30 000</b>
<b>STEP 5</b> MONTH 14-18	<b>ISSUANCE OF WORK PERMIT</b>  <b>ARRIVAL IN CANADA (PEI OR NOVA SCOTIA) TO START YOUR BUSINESS</b>	<b>CAN\$5 000</b>  <b>MINIMUM INVESTMENT OF CAN\$150 000</b>
<b>STEP 6</b> MONTH 24-28	<b>AFTER 12 MONTHS OF BUSINESS OPERATIONS: SUBMISSION OF THE PROVINCIAL NOMINATION REQUEST (APPROXIMATELY 3 MONTHS TO RECEIVE THE NOMINATION)</b>	<b>CAN\$5 000</b>
<b>STEP 7</b> MONTH 40-45	<b>CONFIRMATION OF PERMANENT RESIDENCY</b>
